Anyone living, working, or attending school in New Hampshire is now eligible to join

MANCHESTER, NH (May 16, 2019) – Members First Credit Union recently announced changes to its charter, immediately expanding its field of membership to include anyone living, working, or attending school in the State of New Hampshire. Previously, individuals were eligible to join the credit union if they lived or worked within 25 miles of a Members First branch in Manchester or Bedford.

"In 2019 as we celebrate our 70th anniversary and reflect on where we began in the days of handwritten ledgers compared to the technological advancements of today, expanding our membership field just makes sense," said Bruce Leighton, president and CEO, Members First Credit Union. "With technology like mobile banking, remote check deposit, and online applications, our members can manage their accounts and apply for their next mortgage or auto loan from wherever they are. And, since the credit union belongs to the Co-Op Shared Branching Network, there are branches all across the state accessible to members wishing to conduct in-person transactions."

New members that join but don't live or work near a Members First branch have access to over 5,000 participating credit unions and 30,000 surcharge-free ATMs across the country via the Co-Op Shared Branching and ATM Network. "There's even an app for locating them," said Leighton.

Interested applicants who live, work, or attend school in New Hampshire can join Members First by applying online at MembersFirstNH.org, mailing in a membership application, or visiting one of its branches in Manchester or Bedford.
