A Message From The President

Members First was pleased to have the opportunity to make a \$50,000 donation to Manchester's Safe Station program to help combat the city's opioid epidemic. As you know, the credit union is committed to supporting critical community programs in the area we serve, using funds from an anticipated rebate from the National Credit Union Administration. The NCUA announced anticipated reimbursements totaling \$753 million to all federally-insured credit unions nationwide.

Members First is taking the lead by pledging to donate all of the funds we receive, and we hope to inspire other credit unions to do the same. This is an opportunity for credit unions across the country to collectively make a positive impact on charities at the grassroots, community level. We are confronted with significant issues that impact our community and our members, and believe that building stronger, healthier communities through support of non-profit organizations such as Manchester's Safe Station benefits everyone.

Although the refund isn't anticipated for distribution until later this year, and we're not sure of the exact amount we'll receive, we're compelled to act now to benefit our City during this critical time. We've seen the positive impact the Safe Station program has had in our community and are pleased to support the City's efforts in the fight against substance abuse with our donation.
