McWatters Recognizes New Hampshire's One Members First Credit Union from the GAC Stage

Calling for balanced regulation and appealing to credit unions to work with small community banks while advocating for common goals, National Credit Union Administration Chairman J. Mark McWatters addressed the attendees during the Credit Union National Association's government affairs conference yesterday. "Working together in good faith with mutual respect for the other reflects strength, not weakness," he said.

McWatters, reportedly on the Trump administration's list to be the next director of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau, called for regulation and supervision that is tailored and targeted, and respects "credit unions to make their own business decisions while allowing for innovation and growth.
