Members First Credit Union Celebrates Grand Opening of New Main Office

Ribbon Cutting Ceremony marks the official opening at 7 Salmon Street in Manchester

Manchester, NH (October 20, 2021) - [Members First Credit Union](#) recently celebrated the grand opening of its new main office with a ribbon cutting and reception. The facility is prominently located at 7 Salmon Street in Manchester on land that was vacant for many years at the corner of Elm and Salmon Streets across from the Amoskeag Bridge.

The event began with remarks by Bruce Leighton, president and CEO of Members First Credit Union, and Manchester Mayor, Joyce Craig. As part of the opening celebration, Leighton announced the winner of the credit union's Everyday Hero Promotion and a \$2,500 travel package, and awarded Families in Transition with a \$50,000 check to assist in their mission to end the cycle of homelessness. Leighton, the credit union's board of directors and supervisory members were joined by Mayor Craig to cut the ribbon, marking the official opening of the new building. Following the program, attendees toured the new facility and enjoyed refreshments.

The new main office is an 18,000-square-foot, three-story building offering full-service banking with a two-lane drive-up, onsite parking, and convenient access from the Amoskeag Bridge. In addition to a full-service branch, the new facility houses the credit union's executive management and back-office support teams. All personnel have relocated from the previous headquarters on 44 Bridge Street in Manchester.

"We've been eager to welcome our neighbors and local dignitaries to our new main office," said Bruce Leighton, president and CEO. "With a desire to continue investing in our community during the pandemic, construction began safely last year and the result has been very rewarding. We've received tremendous positive feedback from our membership and the community, and look forward to delivering a better experience for our members each time they walk through these doors."
